

# UC San Diego Undergraduate Regents Scholarship

**Congratulations! Entering Regents Scholars at the University of California, San Diego currently receive the following special privileges and benefits for undergraduate study.**

Annual \$2,000 honorarium (for 4 undergraduate academic years)

Priority enrollment for classes in future quarters

UCSD college of choice at time of admission

College Honors Program and appointment of an Honors Advisor at select colleges

Extended campus library privileges

On-campus housing for four years, provided the housing deadlines are met

Participation in a cutting-edge research program during the first quarter of enrollment, subject to availability. Physical Sciences, Arts & Humanities, Social Sciences, and Engineering are some of the participating divisions.

Participation in the Academic Enrichment Program's Faculty Mentor Program in the junior year, assuming program requirements are met.

## **Need-Based Stipend**

Regents Scholars who apply for financial aid by March 2 and have financial need will have their basic CA resident need (excluding non-resident supplemental tuition) met through the Regents Stipend (which includes the Regents honorarium amount). The Regents stipend will be reduced by any scholarships or benefits awarded by other agencies. A Free Application For Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be filed annually to be evaluated for the stipend. Report to the Financial Aid Office all outside financial assistance, scholarships, and benefits received from all sources throughout the four-year appointment period. Regents Scholarships are not transferable to other University of California campuses.

## **Renewal of Scholarship**

Regents Scholars are required to enroll for a minimum of 12 units per quarter and to make normal progress toward a baccalaureate degree. The minimum academic requirements for renewal of a Regents Scholarship are a 3.0 cumulative UC grade point average and the completion of 36 units each year.

## **Leave of Absence**

Regents Scholars who have been granted an official leave of absence from the University must notify the Scholarship Coordinator by email or in writing at the time of withdrawal in order to retain Regents Scholarship eligibility upon return to the University.
