Undergraduate Scholarship Program

Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis, selected by the Faculty Committee on Undergraduate Scholarships and Honors.

Although every effort is made to present the most accurate and up-to-date information, the information contained herein is subject to change due to federal, state, and university funding limitations or changes in policy and procedure.

Who is Eligible?

- ▶ 2008-2009 UCSD undergraduates, enrolled full-time 2009-2010
- ▶ U.S. citizen/permanent resident (except for the Lima Scholarship)
- ▶ **GPA:** 3.6+ for merit awards, 3.0+ for all other awards
- ▶ Completed less than 15 quarters of college attendance
- ▶ Preference given to non-Regents, non-Jacobs scholars
- ▶ For financial need awards, students must file a FAFSA by March 2, 2009. (And submit additional requested financial aid documents by May 1, 2009.)
- ▶ **If ALL scholarship boxes are checked, the application will NOT be considered.**

How Do I Submit the Application?

- Log on <http://tritonlink.ucsd.edu>
- Under "Tools" on left sidebar, click "Financial Aid." Enter User ID/PID and Password/PAC
- Click the button under "Continuing Undergraduate Scholarship Application"
- Follow step-by-step instructions
- Must complete resume, essay, and required supplemental essay – UNLESS applying for the Erion Scholarship – **but Erion applicants must enter "NONE" in appropriate sections.**
- Changes can be made at any time before the February 23 deadline.

What Does This Application Do?

With this ONE application you will automatically be considered for:

- ▶ ALL Merit awards
- ▶ ALL Financial Need awards (if a financial aid recipient)
- ▶ ALL Restricted awards for which you checked the appropriate box

On-Line Application

► Part I & II: Student Data / Personal Information (Required)

Include degree, career plans, grade level in 2009-10, plans for next year enrollment, etc. **Must be an undergraduate to receive an award.**

► Part III: Restricted Scholarships

Part III is a list of scholarships. Only apply for those scholarships for which you meet the criteria.

Students who check ALL scholarships will NOT be considered.

Scholarships marked with an asterisk (*) require additional information. A box will be provided under the scholarship description for this information - up to 3,000 words + spaces.

► Part IV: Resume (Required – unless you are applying for the merit only scholarships or merit-plus-financial need scholarships)

If you are applying for the merit only scholarships, or merit-plus-financial need scholarships, or have no activities, enter “None” for the application to be considered “Complete.”

The Resume includes four areas:

- 1) Honors /awards, 2) Extracurricular activities (clubs, organizations), 3) Community service, 4) Employment / internships.

You can list activities for the past 3 years – including high school. Indicate leadership roles taken with start and stop dates, or “ongoing.” (Sample Resume attached).

► Part V: Essay (Required – unless you are applying for the merit only or merit-plus-financial need scholarships)

The Essay is required unless you are applying for the merit only, or merit-plus-financial need, awards – in which case, enter **“None”** for the application to be considered **“Complete.”**

There are three essay sections. We recommend you address all sections to provide the Faculty

Scholarship Committee a broad understanding of your strengths, interests, and aspirations.

However, if you can only complete just one or two of the sections, you have fulfilled the essay requirement.

Write about events or circumstances that demonstrate:

Section A: Academic and personal achievements

Section B: Talents, experiences, interests

Section C: Personal and career goals

Each Section: 1,700 characters or less, including spaces (approx. ½ page of 12 font, single space).

There is some flexibility for additional characters / spaces.

There is no spell-check. Use Word, plain text, copy and paste. Use basic formatting (no bullets, indenting, etc. which distort text). **NOTE:** TritonLink has a timeout feature, so make sure you save your information periodically.

► Part VI: Special Circumstances (Optional)

Some scholarships give preference to students with special circumstances.

Examples (but not limited to): Personal or family hardships, first generation college student, re-entry student, single parent, veteran, disability, etc.

Statement: 2,200 characters or less, including spaces (approx. 2/3 page, single-spaced, 12 point font). **NOTE:** TritonLink has a timeout feature, so make sure you save your information periodically.

► Part VII: Certification, Release Agreement, Online Authorization (Required)

This page collects your authorization, certifying that your information is correct, and agreement to the release statement.

If your application is not complete, but you complete Part VII, you will NOT be shown the Confirmation Page. Instead, you will be shown the missing information you need to complete.

► Confirmation Page

After you complete Part VII, the Confirmation Page will appear if your application is complete.

If you do not receive the Confirmation Page, your application may not be complete or saved.

Note: Changes to the application can be made at any time up to the February 23 deadline.

UCSD CONTINUING UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2009-2010

The UCSD Undergraduate Scholarship Program anticipates awarding the following scholarships for the 2009-2010 process.

All scholarships are one-year awards unless otherwise stated.

Check scholarship boxes in Part III only if you meet the criteria.

You may check more than one scholarship if you meet the criteria. However, in most cases, students are awarded only one scholarship.

Students who select ALL Scholarships will NOT be considered.

Scholarships marked with an asterisk (*) require supplemental information. A box is provided for this additional information.

Although every effort is made to present the most accurate information in this publication, this information is subject to change due to federal, state, university funding, and changes in policy or law.

MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

All students are considered automatically for merit scholarships – which are awarded based on academic achievement. Awards are up to \$500.

RESTRICTED SCHOLARSHIPS

Restricted scholarships have additional criteria such as a particular major, leadership, hardship, etc.

For scholarships which include financial need as a criterion, the FAFSA should be submitted by March 2, 2009. (And submit additional requested financial aid documents by May 1, 2009.)

Scholarships Restricted by Financial Need

All students are automatically considered for the merit-plus- financial need awards, if they are receiving financial aid. Financial aid recipients are identified / verified via the financial aid data base.

To meet the financial need criterion, students must submit the FAFSA by March 2, 2009 (and submit additional requested financial aid documents by May 1, 2009).

Awards range from \$500 to \$2,000.

Scholarships Restricted to Fields of Study

*** BAE SYSTEMS Scholarship:** Awarded to full-time **Computer Science, Applied Mathematics, Computer or Electrical Engineering majors with a Computer Science emphasis**, who will be seniors in the 2009-2010 academic year, with a minimum 3.2 GPA, are U.S. citizens and plan to pursue a career in computer science in San Diego. Finalists may be invited for an interview with BAE representatives. This is a one-year award up to \$5,000. *To be considered for this award, information is required in the Essay Section about your interest in the above majors.*

Errett Bishop Scholarship: Awarded to declared **Mathematics** majors, who will be juniors or seniors in 2009-2010, who qualify for financial aid. Preference will be given to students with upper division math course work. This is a one-year award up to \$3,000.

***Boeing Engineering Scholarship:** Awarded to full-time **Electrical, Mechanical, Aerospace, Computer Engineering, or Computer Science** majors, who qualify for financial aid. This is a one-year award up to \$2,000. *Provide information about your interest in the above majors.*

***Ken Bowles Scholarship for CSE:** Awarded to full-time **Computer Science**

Engineering, who will be seniors in 2009-2010, majoring in with a 3.0+ GPA. Preference given to financial need students who have knowledge and/or experience with the UCSD Pascal Application. This is a one-year award up to \$1,500. *Provide information about your interest in Computer Science Engineering your knowledge or experience with the Pascal Application.*

***Gregory T. Bryan Scholarship:** This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to full-time **Social Sciences or Arts & Humanities** majors, juniors or seniors in 2009-2010, with a 3.0+ GPA, majoring in, have demonstrated financial need, and academic, campus, or community leadership as a UCSD undergraduate. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship of up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about your interest in the above majors, and your community service.*

***Cambon Family Scholarship:** This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to full-time **Economics** majors, with a 3.0+ GPA, and have demonstrated financial need, academic, campus, or community leadership. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about the above majors, and your community service.*

CK and Jenny Cheng Scholarship: Awarded to **Computer Science, Electrical or Computer Engineering** majors, at the Jacobs School of Engineering, based on academic merit. This is a one-year award up to \$500.

Cohu, Inc. – James W. Barnes Scholarship: Awarded to full-time current undergraduate students majoring in **Mechanical, Electrical, Computer Engineering or Computer Science**, with a 3.0+ GPA. This is a one-year award up to \$2,500.

*** Thomas E. Curtis Scholarship:** Awarded to **Biology, Chemistry, or Physics** majors, who are juniors or seniors in 2009-2010, with at least a 3.5 GPA. Must demonstrate interest in the larger world around them with leadership level involvement outside the classroom. This is a one-year award up to \$2,000. *Provide information about your interest in the above majors, and your community service.*

*** Klara D. Eckart Scholarship:** Awarded to promising students in **Computation, Mathematics, or Physics**. This is a one-year award and the amount varies up to \$1,000. *Provide information about your interest in the above majors.*

*** Marye Anne Fox and James Whitesell Scholarship:** Awarded to students majoring in **Natural Sciences or Engineering**. Preference is given to students with financial need, and who are dependents of UCSD employees. This is a one-year award and the amount varies. If you are a dependent of a UCSD employee, *provide your parent's name, UCSD Department, and Department phone number.*

***Golf Course Builders Association Scholarship:** Awarded to students who have a 3.0+ GPA, enrolled in **Urban Studies** or related disciplines,

with a career goal of golf course construction, design or development. This is a one-year award and the amount varies up to \$1,000. *Provide information about your interest in golf course construction and design.*

***Hajim Family Scholarship:** Awarded to full-time current undergraduate students, majoring in **Visual Art**, with a 3.0+ GPA, and demonstrated financial need. This is a two-year undergraduate award up to \$2,000. *Provide information about your interest in the above major.*

***Michael Miller Engineering Scholarship for Transfer Students:** Awarded to transfer students who are **Engineering** majors, with a 3.0+ GPA, and who qualify for financial aid. This is a one-year award of up to \$2,500. *Provide information about your interest in the above major.*

*** Karen Moraghan Scholarship:** This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to full-time **Communications** majors, with a 3.0+ GPA, demonstrated need, academic, campus, or community leadership. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about your interest in the above majors and your community service.*

***Philip R. & Pamela Fadem Palisoul Scholarship:** This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to Revelle college undergraduates who have a 3.0+ GPA, financial need, and majoring in **Arts and Humanities**, and have demonstrated academic,

campus or community service. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about your interest in the above majors, and your community service.*

Cheryl Renee Persky Memorial Scholarship: Awarded to **Electrical Engineering or Computer Science** majors. This is a one-year award and the amount varies.

***Tenie Rimmel Memorial Scholarship:** Awarded to **Division of Physical Sciences** majors, based on academic merit, who have financial need. This is a one-year award of up to \$1,000. *Provide information about your interest in Physical Sciences.*

***Gary C. Reynolds Scholarship:** Awarded to **Mathematics-Computer Science** majors, who will be juniors or seniors in 2009-2010, who show exceptional promise for making future contributions in their field of study. Prior recipients of this award are not eligible. This is a non-renewable award. The amount of this award varies up to \$1,500. *Provide information about your interest in the above majors.*

*** C. Robert Wartell Memorial Scholarship:** This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded undergraduate students who have a 3.0+ GPA, demonstrated financial need, and have demonstrated interest in **law or justice**. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about your interest in the above fields.*

***Waxman Family Scholarship:** This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to full-time **Mathematics or Biology** majors, with a **3.4+ GPA**, demonstrated financial need, and academic, campus or community service. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about your interest in the above majors, and your community service.*

*** Robert and Pat Whalen Military Transfer Scholarship:** Awarded to transfer students who have served in the US Armed Forces **as enlisted or non-commissioned officers**, have financial need, and majoring in **Engineering**. Preference given to those who have transferred to UCSD through Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) or UniversityLink. *Provide information about your military service, name of your Community College and, if applicable, indicate if you were a TAG or UniversityLink participant.*

Scholarships Restricted According to Veterans' Status or Ancestors

Brython P. Davis Scholarship: Awarded to students whose parents are or were a regular member of the U.S. Navy or Marine Corps. This is a one-year award and the amount varies. *Verification of U.S. military descendant status is needed only when a scholarship offer is made.*

LaVerne Noyes Foundation Scholarship: Awarded to direct descendants of U.S. World War I

veterans (i.e. four months of U.S. service prior to November 11, 1918), who qualify for financial aid. This is a one-year award and the amount varies. *Verification of U.S. veteran descendant needed only if a scholarship offer is made.*

Scholarships Restricted by Geographic Area

***Bay Area Alumni Scholarship:** This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to full-time students, with a 3.0+ GPA, with demonstrated need, and academic, campus, or community leadership, and has graduated from a high school in the San Francisco Bay Area. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about your community service.*

*** Willis & Jane Fletcher Foundation and P and G Company Scholarship:** This outside agency scholarship is awarded to a 2009-2010 sophomore who is a graduate of a San Diego County high school, who qualifies for financial aid, and has demonstrated community service. This is a one-year award up to \$2,500. *Provide information about your community service.*

***Walsh Chacon Malone Scholarship:** This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to full-time students, with a 3.0+ GPA, demonstrated need, who come from zip codes 92113, 91950, 92154, or 91910, or are UCSD Preuss School graduates and has demonstrated academic, campus, or community

leadership. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about your community service.*

Other Restricted Scholarships

***Alumni Leadership**

Scholarships: The Brutton, Conway, Fitzmaurice, Lehrer, Nelson, O'Leary, and Alumni Leadership Scholarships were established by generous UCSD Alumni and are awarded to full-time students, with a 3.0+ GPA, demonstrated financial need, and demonstrated academic, campus, or community leadership. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about your community service.*

***Tom Bond Revelle College**

Scholarship: Awarded to Revelle College students who will be seniors in 2009-2010, have a 3.7+ GPA, and participated in significant extra-curricular campus activity. This is a minimum \$1,000 one-year award. *Provide information about your campus/community service.*

***Jaye Haddad Memorial**

Scholarship: Awarded to students diagnosed with cancer, Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS), AIDS-related conditions, or students with physical disabilities, and demonstrated financial need. Award amount is up to \$1,000. *Supplemental information is required about your health or physical challenges.*

***Kevin T. Hart Memorial**

Scholarship: This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to full-time students,

with a 3.0+ GPA, demonstrated financial need, academic, campus or community service, and has experienced either mental illness or homelessness personally or through experiences of a family member. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about experience with mental illness or homelessness, and your community service.*

***I Pledge Student**

Scholarship: This scholarship was established by the UCSD Student Foundation and paid for by current students through quarterly donations. Awarded to continuing students who have demonstrated a commitment to building the UCSD community. This is a one-year award up to \$2,000. *Provide information about your campus building community service/involvement.*

Iranian-American Student's

Scholarship: This outside agency scholarship is awarded to students who are of Iranian or Iranian -American descent with financial need and academic merit. These are one-year awards up to \$1,000.

Note: Students who check this box will be sent an email inviting them to complete a separate Iranian-American Scholarship Application.

***Jeffrey R. Leifer Leadership**

Scholarship: Awarded to current students who have qualified for financial aid, demonstrate academic achievement, are the first generation in their family to attend college, and graduates from California high schools that have historically been underrepresented at UC campuses. This is a one-year award and the amount varies up to \$1,000. *Supplemental*

information is required about your parents' level of education and your motivation to attend college as a first generation college student.

*** Joseph H. Lima**

Scholarship: This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to financial need students from an immigrant family (student or parents born outside the U.S.), have immigrated or are immigrating to the U.S., including someone with visa status of "asylee". *Supplemental information required about your immigrant status/experience, and social community service or academic leadership.*

*** Marchick-Rallo**

Scholarship: This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to undergraduates who have a 3.0+ GPA, financial need, have demonstrated campus, academic or community leadership, and have or are participating in UCSD Student Government. This is a two-year scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide information about your UCSD Student Government participation, and community service.*

***George Parker Memorial**

Scholarship: Awarded based on financial need to students who were orphaned for at least 3 years prior the age of 18, and/or who were raised in foster care for at least 3 years immediately prior to the age of 18. This is a renewable award, paid in the amount of up to \$2,000 annually. Verification of orphan or foster care status is needed only if a scholarship offer is made. *Supplemental information required regarding circumstances in which you*

became a foster child or orphan and the challenges you have experienced or overcome.

Sven Peterson Memorial

Scholarship: Awarded to a 2009-2010 Warren College sophomore or junior, majoring in an area other than engineering or life sciences, who has been named to the Warren College Provost's Honors list at least one quarter and has a 3.0+ cumulative GPA. This is a one-year \$2,000 award. Students may reapply.

***Senior Gift Scholarship:** This scholarship was established by UCSD graduating seniors to recognize outstanding 2009-2010 seniors, or senior-transfer students, who have qualified for financial aid and have demonstrated the philanthropic spirit through community service. This is a one-year award, up to \$1,000. *Provide information about your community service.*

***Malcolm R. Stacey Memorial Scholarship:** Award amounts of \$500-\$2,000 are awarded in the following priority:

1. Undergraduate Jewish students who are orphans and preparing for graduate study in aeronautical engineering. Provide background on your experience as an orphan.
2. Undergraduate Jewish students in the field of aeronautical engineering.
3. Jewish students majoring in engineering.
4. Jewish students in any field of study.

*** UC San Diego Faculty-Staff Employee Dependent**

Scholarship: Awarded to students with a 3.0+ GPA, demonstrated financial need, who are daughters or sons of UCSD

employees. This is a one-year scholarship and the amount varies. *Provide your parent's name, UCSD Department, and Department phone number.*

***UCSD Town and Gown**

Scholarship: Awarded to full-time 2009-2010 juniors or seniors, with a 3.4+ GPA, demonstrated financial need, who show exceptional promise for making future contributions in public or community service (including but not limited to foreign affairs, medicine, social service, political science). This is a one year award up to \$5,000. *Provide information about your interest in pursuing a career in public or community service.*

***Patricia Ordonez Valva**

Scholarship: This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to full-time students, with a 3.0+ GPA, demonstrated financial need, and academic, campus, or community leadership, and have suffered the death of a parent from cancer or who has cancer affecting an immediate family member. This is a one-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Supplemental information to include undergraduate community service and special circumstances that qualify you for this award.*

***Vickerman/Munoz Family Scholarship for Transfer**

Students: This Alumni Leadership Scholarship is awarded to full-time transfer students, with a 3.0+ GPA, demonstrated financial need, and academic/campus, or community leadership. This is a two-year undergraduate scholarship up to \$2,000 annually. *Provide*

information about your community service.
